AWIC, the Indian Section of the International Board on Books for Young People (Ind. BBY) is organising a three-day INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON LITERACY THROUGH LITERATURE from 6 to 8 February, 2014 at India Habitat Centre, New Delhi, India.

The International Conference on Literacy through Literature is an effort to promote literacy by inculcating the habit of reading among children. Literacy has been commonly defined as proficiency in the three R's - reading, writing and arithmetic. More recently however, literacy has come to include technological, visual and other aspects of literacy and education, both formal and non-formal. In fact, the Right to Education has been recognised worldwide as one of the fundamental rights of the child. Books and reading can play a crucial role in the promotion and sustenance of literacy. An increase in literacy will no doubt promote human development and lead to a better world. The International Conference on Literacy through Literature provides a platform for eminent authors, illustrators, educationists, NGOs and researchers to highlight the importance of literature in promoting literacy for the all-round development of the child.
