In fact, the Right to Education has been recognised worldwide as one of the fundamental rights of the child.

Books and reading can play a crucial role in the promotion and sustenance of literacy. An increase in literacy will no doubt promote human development and lead to a better world. The Association of Writers and Illustrators for Children (AWIC/IndianBBY), a voluntary organisation founded in 1981 by the Late K. Shankar Pillai, has been actively involved in developing good literature for children and promoting the reading habit through its different activities. AWIC launched the AWIC Literacy Project in 1995, and has published alphabet books in several Indian languages.
